

Fireworks.

- a) Fireworks means firecrackers, Roman candles, torpedoes, sky rockets and any and all explosives commonly known and referred to as fireworks; the term fireworks shall not include auto flares, toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns and other devices in which paper caps manufactured in accordance with the United States Interstate Commerce Commission regulations for packing and shipping of toy paper caps are used, or toy pistol paper caps manufactured as provided under the law, the use of which shall be permitted at all times.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person, corporation, association, or other entity to sell or discharge fireworks within the municipal corporate limits of the city, except during the dates of June 15 through July 5 and December 20 through January 2 and except during the hours identified below during said dates.
- (c) During the dates set forth above fireworks may be discharged only during the following hours on the days designated:
 - (1) July 3, 4 and 5 and December 30, 31 and January 1 - Between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and midnight.
 - (2) Other days - between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- (d) Any person, corporation, association, or other entity convicted, pleading guilty to, or pleading no contest to a violation of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall pay a fine as follows:
 - (1) One hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the first offense;
 - (2) Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for a second offense;
 - (3) Three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for a third and subsequent offenses.
